



## Video 22: Editing ID3 Tags in Audio files

Each audio file in StoryPhones contains Tags, which give you a bit more information such as the author and what the story or song is about.

You can edit these tags and even add your own picture to identify the track. This information appears in the MP3 player panel whenever a track is selected.

### How to edit ID3 tags

- To edit ID3 tags, right click on the track, and in the pop-up window, select 'Edit ID3 Tags'.
- Another pop-up window will then appear and you can click in any of the three boxes to edit the tag information such as title, author and description.
- You can also add an image to the track as long as the image size is not too big You must make sure that the file size is less than 4 kilobytes or that the image is no more than 250 x 250 pixels. Image files should be jpeg type.
- To add an image file, click the 'Browse' button in the ID3 tag window and select the folder which contains the image you want to use. The folder will appear in the browser window. Select the image file you want to add and click 'Ok'.
- Once you're happy with the tags, click the 'Save' button and you will see your new tags displayed.
