



Video 19: Importing MP3 tracks from your computer

- You can import MP3 tracks that you have downloaded from web sites or other sources. MP3 tracks with bit rates up to 256 kilobits per second can be used with StoryPhones. ***You need to be in adult mode to do this.***
- In the BookShelf software, move to the folder in which you wish to add the tracks and double click on the add content icon on the bookshelf.
- A pop up window will now appear. Select the option to *'Import files from my PC...'*
- You can now browse to the folder or USB memory stick containing the files to be imported. When you've found them click OK.
- The MP3 files contained within the folder will be displayed and you can click on the box next to each track to select it for import.
- Click the *'Import checked'* button to add the files to the BookShelf library.
- Once the files have been imported, the window will disappear and the tracks will show in the currently displayed folder. You can now edit the tags for these files if you wish. For more information you can watch the ID3 tag editing video.
- Alternatively, you can click the blue *'Add MP3 files...'* button in the settings window and follow the same process.
